

The venue is The Old Race Course Low Moor Richmond, hosted Richmond & Zetland Harriers.

Low Moor is high above Richmond and on a good day has fantastic views north over The Aske Estate towards Aycllffe, east over Teesside and south across Wensleydale, Pen Hill and beyond. Even on a not-so-good day, when there is wind and rain, it is still invigorating!

The course is mostly around the perimeter, along a mixture of paths and the all weather track that the racehorses use when training - not this afternoon. The 2K short lap has a single climb up to the ruins of the Old Grandstand and down whilst the 2.5K long lap has two climbs plus a loop around the western end. Although suitable for spikes, studs or robust trainers, care must be taken with the many molehills and rabbit holes. The course will be adequately signed and marshaled where necessary and competitors are reminded not to cut corners, as disqualification could prove costly.

Manufacturers - postcode DL 10 4SU for those with Sat Nav. The car park will be signed and is to be used as a drop-off point only - for Clubs with tents and Officials. Everybody is asked to park politely on the many roads of the Trading Estate.
